CUSTOMS POWER OF ATTORNEY

General authority for customs business at all U.S. Customs and Border Protection ports and Centers

2. APPOINTMENT AND AUTHORITY

The principal identified above hereby appoints KARTASH INC., a New York corporation located at 77 Sands Street, Brooklyn, New York 11201, acting through its licensed officers and authorized employees, as the principal's true and lawful agent and attorney to transact customs business in the name and on behalf of the principal at all U.S. Customs and Border Protection ports and Centers.

This is a general power of attorney with authority to perform every lawful act necessary or appropriate in connection with the importation, transportation, exportation, entry, withdrawal, or other customs treatment of merchandise, as more specifically described on the following page.

AUTHORITY GRANTED

The principal hereby constitutes and appoints KARTASH INC. & DULY AUTHORIZED EMPLOYEES AND THEIR AGENTS, a corporation organized under the laws of the State of New York, as the true and lawful agent and attorney of the principal named above, for and in the name, place, and stead of said principal from this date, in all Customs Districts and in no other name:

To make, endorse, sign, declare, or swear to any entry, drawback claim, withdrawal, declaration, certificate, bill of lading, carnet, or other document required by law or regulation in connection with the importation, transportation, or exportation of any merchandise shipped or consigned by or to said principal, including authorization of ISF (Importer Security Filing) on the principal's behalf; to perform any act or condition which may be required by law or regulation in connection with such merchandise; and to receive any merchandise deliverable to said principal.

To make endorsements on bills of lading conferring authority to transfer title, make entry, or collect drawback; and to make, sign, declare, or swear to any statement, supplemental statement, schedule, supplemental schedule, certificate of delivery, certificate of manufacture, certificate of manufacture and delivery, abstract of manufacturing records, declaration of proprietor on drawback entry, declaration of exporter on drawback entry, or any other affidavit or document which may be required by law or regulation for drawback purposes, regardless of whether such bill of lading, sworn statement, schedule, certificate, abstract, declaration, affidavit, or other document is intended for filing in any Customs District.

To sign, seal, and deliver for and as the act of said principal any bond required by law or regulation in connection with the entry or withdrawal of imported merchandise, or merchandise exported with or without benefit of drawback; in connection with the entry, clearance, lading, unlading, or navigation of any vessel or other means of conveyance owned or operated by said principal; and any and all bonds which may be voluntarily given and accepted under applicable laws and regulations, including consignee's and owner's declarations provided for in section 485 of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended, or affidavits in connection with the entry of merchandise.

AUTHORITY GRANTED — CONTINUED

To sign and swear to any document and to perform any act that may be necessary or required by law or regulation in connection with the entering, clearing, lading, unlading, or operation of any vessel or other means of conveyance owned or operated by said principal.

To authorize other licensed Customs Brokers to act as the principal's agent; to receive, endorse, and collect checks issued for Customs duty refunds in the principal's name and drawn on the Treasurer of the United States; and, if the principal is a nonresident of the United States, to accept service of process on behalf of the principal.

And generally to transact at the customshouses in any district any and all customs business, including making, signing, and filing protests under section 514 of the Tariff Act of 1930, in which said principal is or may be concerned or interested and which may properly be transacted or performed by an agent and attorney, giving said agent and attorney full power and authority to do anything requisite and necessary to be done in the premises as fully as said principal could do if present and acting, hereby ratifying and confirming all that said agent and attorney shall lawfully do by virtue of these presents.

DURATION AND REVOCATION

The foregoing power of attorney remains in full force and effect until the optional expiration date stated below, or until written notice of revocation is duly given to and received by Kartash Inc. and, when applicable, U.S. Customs and Border Protection. If the principal is a partnership, this power of attorney expires no later than two years from the date of execution, as required by 19 CFR 141.34.

DIRECT BROKER-IMPORTER RELATIONSHIP

The principal confirms that this power of attorney is executed directly with Kartash Inc. and not through a freight forwarder or other third party. Nothing in any forwarding or referral arrangement may prevent direct communication between the principal and Kartash Inc.

REQUIRED NOTICE REGARDING CUSTOMS CHARGES

If you are the importer of record, payment to the broker will not relieve you of liability for customs charges (duties, taxes, or other debts owed CBP) in the event the charges are not paid by the broker. Therefore, if you pay by check, customs charges may be paid with a separate check payable to the "U.S. Customs and Border Protection" which will be delivered to CBP by the broker.
